SCHOOL HOLIDAY KIDS CLUB **SAFETY RULES.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/ GUARDIANS AND CHILDREN:

To ensure the safety of children and your peace of mind, the following rules of operation will be enforced at all times.

- Please remember Blue Lagoon Beach Resort Kids Club offers optional activities for children, **it is not a baby sitting service and should not be treated as one.**
- Children under the age of 10 years will be required to be dropped off and collected from each activity by a parent or guardian. Please inform the staff of any special needs your child has.
- If you plan to have a different person pick up your child, we must be notified at the time of drop off.
- Where possible, children over the age of 10 years are encouraged to remain for the entire activity.
- When possible parents must remain within the resort grounds when children are taking part in activities, otherwise they must be easily contactable by mobile phone or leave the name and number of someone within the resort who will take responsibility for their children.
- Kids Club staff are not authorised to administer any prescription or non-prescription medication. These must be administered by parents or guardians.
- All participating children must be wearing appropriate footwear for each activity.
- The parent/guardian is responsible for the behaviour of their child. Uncontrollable behaviour will not be tolerated. If a child behaves improperly, towards staff or fellow children, the parent/guardian will be called to reception to collect their child.
- Parents are encouraged to supply sunscreen and protective clothing from the sun. When activities are conducted outdoors children will be required to wear hats and sunscreen.
- Parents must supply children with drinks as to keep them well hydrated during physical activities in the heat.
- While all care is taken with children's belongings, Blue Lagoon Kids Club is not responsible for any lost or stolen articles while children are participating in activities.
